Typical projects include hedge laying, fence building, coppicing, dry stone walling and scrub clearance on wild flower meadows and chalk grassland. No previous experience is required and we aim to welcome all volunteers.

Members elect the committee who run the OCV, and may take part in residential trips and training days. Your membership fee goes towards running costs, and a healthy membership roll is helpful when applying for grant funding. A donation of £10 or more (£5 or more if you're a student, retired or otherwise unwaged) entitles you to membership for the current calendar year.

Membership is not required; members and non-members alike are very much welcomed as volunteers.
